Re: Right-to-Know Law Request No. 20-0314

Dear Requestor:

This letter follows the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's ("PennDOT") correspondence acknowledging receipt of your written correspondence, which was processed under the Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law ("RTKL"), 65 P.S. § 67.101 et seq. We mailed a letter to you on June 11, 2020 providing notice that we required a thirty (30) days' extension, as permitted by the RTKL. This response is provided pursuant to that extension. While offices remain closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and we have not yet technically resumed with a subsequent "business day" for purposes of the computation of such days in due course, in the interest of transparency, we are resuming operations insofar as possible and we offer this letter as our final response. A copy of your correspondence is enclosed.

You requested the following:

... [F]rom the period of January 1, 2010 to June 4, 2020 as follows:

- (1) A listing of receipts to the Motorcycle Safety Education Account showing (for each transaction) the source of the funds, the amount, and the date deposited.
- (2) A listing of all disbursements from the Motorcycle Safety Education Account showing (for each transaction) the recipient of the funds, the amount, the date disbursed, and the reason for the expenditure.
- (3) A running balance for the Motorcycle Safety Education Account for the period in question showing the total amount of funds in the account on the date of all transactions.

Your request is granted. Enclosed are records responsive to your request.

Please be advised that this correspondence will serve to close your RTKL request with our office as permitted by law.
